Downunder Tradies will assist you in acquiring the necessary documents and accreditations required for you to work in the UK Construction Industry **before** you leave Australia, New Zealand or South Africa. The following is a comprehensive list of how we can help you get started on your great adventure.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Electrotechnical Certification Scheme (ECS) Health & Safety Assessment – ECS Certificate

Electricians must gain an ECS Certificate to demonstrate health and safety awareness in order to work on any UK construction sites. The Certificate is gained through passing a 30 minute, computer based, Health & Safety Assessment consisting of 40 multiple choice questions. You will be provided with a Study Booklet to prepare you for the assessment before you arrive. On your arrival in the UK we will schedule an assessment date convenient for you. The ECS Certificate is compulsory when applying for Joint Industry Board (JIB) Grading (*see point 3 below*). *The ECS Assessment is held at our Test Centre in the Downunder Tradies offices in West London.*

2. City & Guilds 2382-10 (17th Edition) Course - For Level 3 Certificate in the Requirements for Electrical Installations

You will need to gain the City & Guilds Level 3 Certificate in order to be graded at the highest level for electricians in the UK Construction Industry (*see point 3 below*). By gaining this qualification you are demonstrating having a sound knowledge of the format, content and application of the IEE Wiring Regulations 17th Edition BS 7671:2008 (the national standard for the electrical industry in respect of safe use and operation of electrical equipment and systems in the United Kingdom). This qualification is gained through passing a 2 hour, GOLLA online exam, consisting of 60 multiple choice questions. We will provide you with the IEE Wiring Regulations Seventeenth Edition Book and Home Study Course CD-ROM to thoroughly prepare you for the exam (*Printed study material is available on request for those without a PC*). On your arrival in the UK we will schedule an exam date convenient for you. *The City & Guilds 2382-10 (17th Edition) Exam is held at our Test Centre in the Downunder Tradies offices in West London. 3. Joint Industry Board (JIB) Grading - JIB Card

The JIB will issue you with a Card (licence) to show the level of grading you have achieved within your occupation, taking into account all the qualifications you have gained. An application form will need to be completed and your qualifications submitted (Certificate of Apprenticeship and Transcripts/ECS Certificate/City & Guilds Level 3 Certificate & results) along with employer references, to the JIB to be assessed. You will then be issued with either:

- A **JIB Gold Card** (*if you have gained the City & Guilds Level 3 Certificate in the Requirements for Electrical Installations – see point 2 above*). This is the highest available grading for electricians in the UK.

- A **JIB Senior Electrical Trainee Card** (*if you have not gained the City & Guilds Level 3 Certificate in the Requirements for Electrical Installations*). Although this card will get you on site, you will not be able to carry out all of the electrical duties that may be required, limiting your job possibilities and potential rate of pay.

We will act as your sponsor, organise and submit your JIB Application.

The processing time for JIB Applications can be anywhere up to 8 weeks. A 'fast track' option is available giving you an appointment at the JIB in Sidcup, Kent for same day processing of your Card. If you wish to fast track your JIB Application an additional fee will apply.

PREPARING FOR WORK

1. Registration with Downunder Tradies

A one on one interview is available upon your arrival in the UK to register your details with Downunder Tradies and finalise any requirements to get you on site.

2. Self Employment, Construction Industry Scheme (CIS) and Unique Tax Reference (UTR)

To work in the UK Construction Industry you will need to register as self employed as you will be working as a subcontractor. You will also need to register within the CIS. This allows you to work in the Industry at the standard tax rate of 20%. If you do not register you will be taxed at the higher rate of 30%. Once you have registered within the CIS you will receive a UTR. This number is used to verify you in the Construction Industry. We will assist and advise you on the necessary steps that must be taken to address all of these requirements.

You must have a NI Number to register within the CIS.

3. Tools

A range of tools are required when working on construction sites in the UK. We have teamed up with a local wholesaler and put together a quality tool pack available for you to purchase at a fair price. It is advisable to bring your hand tools and cordless drill over with you and purchase any additional tools once you are here.
